In 2023, **Makassed Foundation of America** celebrates 25 years of humanitarian work in Lebanon, and thrusts forward in its mission of providing humanitarian assistance to alleviate human suffering in Lebanon; particularly during the country's unprecedented economic and financial crisis.

Since 1999, MFA dedicated its mission to provide humanitarian support to the people of Lebanon in three main fields: Education, healthcare, and social welfare.

2022 year in review:

The generosity of its donors and MFA's hard work raised \$995,000 worth of donations in 2022, which were used in Lebanon for:

Education

Providing 150 students with full or partial scholarship at Makassed schools.

Healthcare

Providing equipment, medicine, hospital beds, and supporting the treatment of 270 patients in need at Makassed General Hospital;

Social Welfare

Distributing 3,000 food parcels, blankets and clothing to underprivileged families across Lebanon and conducting professional training sessions for 50 needy women at Ward Al Makassed.
