With Lebanon entering its fourth year of a stifling economic crisis, which pulled around 80% of the population into poverty, the country topped the list of countries most affected by food price inflation.

With the crises in Lebanon expanding and intensifying, its people will need significant humanitarian assistance in 2024 and without concentrated efforts the food, healthcare and education security outlook will further deteriorate. Since 1999, MFA dedicated its mission to provide humanitarian support to the people of Lebanon in three main fields: Education, healthcare, and social welfare.

A look back at key moments in 2023

MFA efforts remain underway to ensure humanitarian action is a top priority to aid those who are truly in need. The generosity of its donors and MFA's hard work raised \$2,435,000 worth of donations in 2023, which were used in Lebanon for:

- **Education:** Providing 400 students with full or partial scholarship at Makassed schools;
- **Healthcare:** Providing equipment, medicine, hospital beds, and supporting the treatment of 350 patients in need at Makassed General Hospital;
- **Social Welfare:** Distributing 3,900 food parcels, blankets and clothing to underprivileged families across Lebanon and conducting professional training sessions for 50 needy women at Ward El Makassed Center.
